### Cocktails

#### Sazerac

Sazerac rye, Courvoisier, Angostura & Peychaud bitters, spray of Absinthe, lemon zest

#### Rusty Nail

J & B scotch, Drambul and orange bitters on the rocks

#### Irish Nail

Jameson whiskey, Irish Mist and orange bitters on the rocks

#### Bearface Smash

Bearface Whisky, lemon juice, simple syrup, mint leaves

#### Old Fashioned

Wild Turkey bourbon, dash of bitters, brown simple syrup, splash of water, ice ball, orange zest, cherry

#### Bourbon Alexander

Wild Turkey bourbon, Kahlua, Crème de Cacao, half and half

#### Nutty Irishman

Jameson whiskey, Amaretto, simple syrup, egg white, lemon juice, cinnamon sprinkle

#### Boulevardier

Wild Turkey bourbon, Campari, sweet vermouth, ice ball

#### Rob Roy

J & B Scotch, sweet vermouth, Angostura bitters, cherry

#### Manhattan

Wild Turkey bourbon, sweet vermouth, cherry

#### Whisky Sour

Canadian whisky, lemon Juice, simple syrup, egg white, cherry

#### Vieux Carre

Sazerac rye, B&B liqueur, sweet vermouth, Peychaud & Angostura bitters



## Single Malt Scotches

### Speyside

*Sixty percent of the scotch produced in Scotland comes from this area.*

#### Aberlour A'Bunadh

Meaning 'the original' in Gaelic, A'bunadh has achieved a cult following among malt lovers **\$19**

#### The Balvenie – Doublewood

One of the classic after-dinner malts, Balvenie Doublewood's extra complexity and richness are a result of a second maturation in fresh sherry casks. Great stuff **\$15**

#### Cardhu 12yr

Pioneered by Helen and Elizabeth Cumming, two of the earliest female distillers, this medium gold dram is known for its sweet aromatics and rich palate of orange, dark chocolate, delicate smoke & toffee **\$14**

#### Cragganmore 12yr

This Speyside is rich and spicy, with a very satisfying complexity and well-sherried backbone **\$14**

#### Dalwhinnie 15 yr

Rated 95 points by Jim Murray. An underrated classic with just a hint of smoke. Lots of apple, pear and toffee **\$15**

#### Glenfiddich 12 yr

The world's number one selling single malt. Glenfiddich accounts for 35% of the world's single malt scotch sales! **\$10**

#### Glenfiddich IPA

First they made the beer and then aged it in barrels for a month. They then took the barrels to the distillery and aged the scotch in the same IPA barrels. A noble experiment **\$12**

#### Glenfiddich XX

A collaboration of 20 Malt masters to pick 20 barrels and then marry them together for one stupendous single malt **\$18**

#### Glenfiddich 21yr

##### Gran Reserva

Finished in Caribbean Rum soaked casks to give this well aged whisky notes of vanilla & toffee sweetness. Complex and smoky with a nose of leather and oak **\$55**

#### The Glenlivet 12yr

The world's second most consumed single malt. Grassy and light with floral notes **\$10**

#### The Glenlivet Archive 21yr

The nose is full and rich with notes of sandalwood and pine with a long sweet finish. Highly regarded by the world's whisky lovers **\$40**

#### Macallan 12yr Sherry Oak

Crisp and sweet with notes of sultanas and fresh apple blossom. One of the best out there in its age group **\$14**

## WHISKEY ROOM

### Highland

---

#### Dalmore 12yr

Aged in Bourbon Barrels then half is transferred to Sherry barrels to finish. The two halves are blended back together for a fruit forward; sweet and rich whisky **\$15**

#### Glenmorangie 10yr Original

The backbone of the Glenmorangie whiskeys. Fruity and thick with a long malty finish **\$12**

#### Oban 14yr

The distillery was built in 1794. The whisky takes the best of the highlands and combines it with the peaty flavours of the Islands **\$20**

#### Old Pulteney Single Cask 2004

Sweet toffee, honeyed vanilla, spiced licorice followed by apple and citrus zest. 1 cask / 620 bottles made worldwide **\$20**

### Lowlands

---

#### Auchentoshan 12yr

An aroma of caramelized almonds and vanilla make this the Crème Brûlée of scot **\$12**

#### Glenkinchie 12yr

Based close to Edinburgh it has come to be known as the Edinburgh malt. You will pick up notes of lemon grass then a spicier lively finish **\$14**

### Islay

---

#### Ardbeg 10yr

This is a big powerful whisky filled with smoke! Citrus and pear notes squeeze their way through but the smoke lingers for hours **\$14**

#### Bowmore 12yr

The peaty smokiness of this Islay favourite is balanced with lemon and honey **\$12**

#### Bruichladdich Laddie

Delicate aromas of honey and dried fruit combine with flavours of caramel and apricots with a light smokiness indicative of Islays **\$12**

#### Lagavulin 16yr

Intense and smoky-sweet. Seaweed flavours with a big smoky finish. Double gold medal at the World Spirit awards 2017 **\$20**

#### Laphroaig 10yr

Very peaty with hints of honey and black pepper. A touch of water adds to the nuances of this whisky **\$12**

### Isle of Skye

---

#### Talisker 10 yr

A fresh and fragrant nose. Through thick, pungent smoke comes sweet pear and apple peels, with pinches of maritime salt from kippers, seaweed **\$15**
